

# Support Your Sport NB Gold Rush - How to Play

#### Overview

- **1.** Operator: Sport New Brunswick (Licensed by NB Lottery). Administrator/ERS Vendor: Causable Inc (Charlottetown, PEI).
- **2.** Game Description: Player's register, purchase numbers, and activate them weekly for a chance to win. Unactivated (not paid) numbers cannot win.
- **3.** Eligibility: Must be 19+ and located in New Brunswick at registration and activation. Employees of Sport New Brunswick (Operator) and Causable Inc. (Administrator), or members of their immediate families/households are ineligible to play.

### **Getting Started**

This section provides a quick overview of the essential steps to participate in the Gold Rush 50/50 raffle. Follow these 6 steps to register, receive ticket strips, and set up payment and Autoplay. For more detailed instructions, refer to the **'How to Play'** section below.

- Register via the SYSNB Gold Rush website (<u>https://sysnb.goldrush.causable.io</u>). Provide your name and email address to register and receive important notifications such as winner announcements.
- 2. Show your Support: Select the sport organization/club you want to support; a portion of your weekly contribution will go directly to that sport organization/club.
- 3. Receive Your First Ticket Strip: Upon registration, you receive a strip of 3 tickets with sequentially assigned numbers.
- 4. Purchase Additional Strips (Optional): Tap "Buy more tickets" to purchase up to 4 strips (12 tickets total) for a maximum of \$20 weekly.
- 5. Activate Autoplay (Optional): Choose to automatically play selected ticket strips in future draws.
- 6. Set Up Payment: Follow the on-screen instructions to pay for your selected strips using a valid credit card or credit/debit card.

#### **How to Play**



Gold Rush is a 50/50 raffle where you purchase assigned ticket numbers that are "permanently" yours.

You can choose to play your ticket numbers weekly, or not. If you choose to "activate" (pay for) your numbers and one is drawn, you will win half the pot. If you choose not to activate (do not pay for) your numbers and one of your numbers is drawn, you are a nonwinner and the pot will "Rollover".

## Supporting Organizations: "Support Your Sport"

When you register, you are prompted to choose which sport you would like to support. You select the sport organization/club you want to support, and a portion of your purchase will be directed to that organization every time you play.

You can change your selected organizations anytime via the "Manage Your Donation" icon on the Dashboard.

#### **Purchase Ticket Strips:**

Each strip has 3 tickets for \$5.00. You can buy up to 4 strips (12 tickets) weekly for a maximum of \$20.00.

Use the "Buy More Tickets" button to purchase another strip of 3 tickets (4 strips max). Use the "Pay & Play" button to activate tickets that do not have Autoplay.

### **Autoplay Option:**

Turn Autoplay on by tapping the grey circle to the left of your ticket strip(s). Autoplay will automatically bill your credit card at the start of each draw (Thursday at 1:01pm) and activate your selected strip(s) for the next draw.

Turn Autoplay off by tapping on the red circle to the left of your ticket strip(s).

### **Ticket Strips:**

All purchased ticket strips are permanently yours. You can choose to play or not play them each week. If a strip is not activated for a draw, it appears grey on your dashboard. Just tap Pay+Play next to the ticket strip(s) you want to enter the next draw then follow the on-screen instructions to pay.

Each week you can decide which ticket strips to play, or you can set them to Autoplay, and they will be activated automatically.

#### **Draws and Prizes:**

- Draw Schedule: Draws occur every Thursday at 1:00 pm Atlantic.
- Prize: 50% of the total pot goes to the winner.
- Odds of Winning: Dependent on the total number of activated ticket numbers.



- Winner Notification: Winners are contacted via email and paid within 30 days. The winner's name is also displayed in the "Winner's Circle."
- Pot Rollover: If a number is drawn that was not activated, the pot rolls over to the next draw.
